Officers and faculty from both the institutions were also present during a brief signing in ceremony held at SKUAST-K.

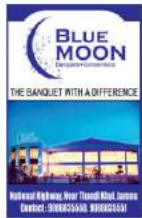

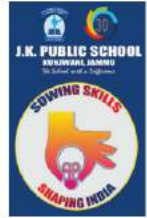
